

The following outlines the donor charter for St Francis dispensary with a view to delivery of our Trust Deed objectives.

Trust Deed Objectives -

- a) To establish and maintain dispensaries for animals and the provision of veterinary advices and treatment of all kinds of sick and injured animals belonging to members of the public who are unable to meet the cost of private veterinary treatment.
- b) To organise lectures and meetings for the education of the public in the care of sick, injured, and healthy animals.
- c) To publish leaflets, pamphlets, and other suitable information for promoting the work of the Society, and
- d) To co-operate and or affiliate with other bodies or individuals having similar objectives.

Our donor policy -

- Our pledge is to treat all our donors with respect, honesty and openness.

- Be assured that information about your donation is handled with respect and confidentiality in accordance with all data legislation.
- Be assured any engagement with an individual representing St Francis will be professional.
- Be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees or hired third party agents.
- Have easily available the agreed procedures for making and responding to complaints.
- Have the opportunity for any names to be deleted from our mailing list and will not have your details shared with any 3rd party without your permission unless otherwise expressly advised at signup point.
- Receive prompt, truthful, and forthright answers to questions you might have of the organisation.
